# Junior Level Science Scholarships Program

The program aims to provide scholarships that will finance the education of talented students in their **third year of college** and who are **pursuing priority degree programs in the areas of science and technology**; and ensure a steady, adequate supply of qualified S&T human resources who can steer the country towards national progress.

## TYPES OF SCHOLARSHIP

### MERIT

The **DOST-SEI Merit Scholarship Program**, formerly known as the **NSDB** or **NSTA Scholarship** under **Republic Act No. 2067**, is awarded to students with high aptitude in Science and Mathematics who are willing to pursue careers in the fields of science and technology.

### RA 7687

The **Republic Act No. 7687**, also known as the **"Science and Technology Scholarship Act of 1994,"** provides for scholarships to talented students whose family's socio-economic status does not exceed the set cut-off values of certain indicators. Qualifiers must pursue priority fields of study in the basic sciences, engineering, other applied sciences, and science and mathematics teaching.

### RA 10612

The **Republic Act No. 10612** also known as the **"Fast-tracked S&T Scholarship Act of 2013,"** aims to strengthen the country's S&T education by fast-tracking graduates in the sciences, mathematics and engineering who shall teach science and mathematics in secondary schools.
